**Outcome 3:** information is used

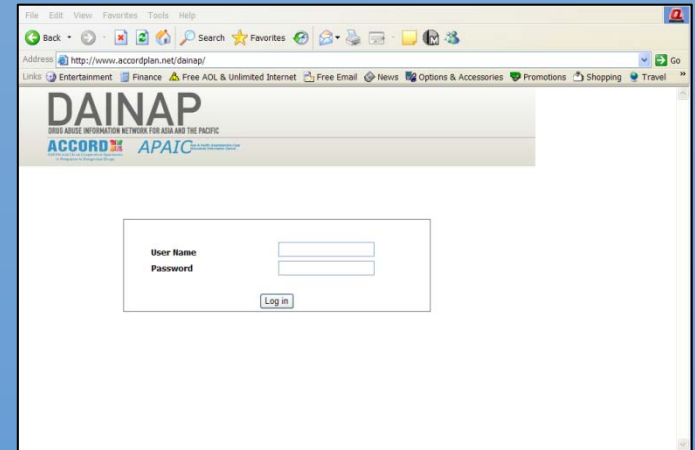
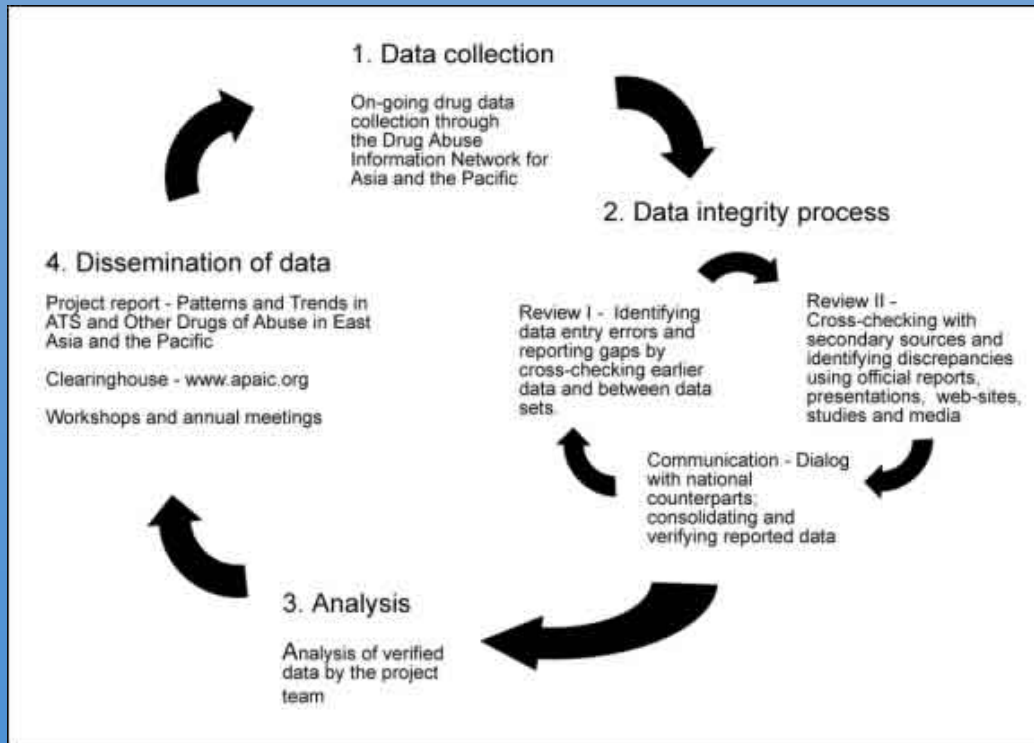

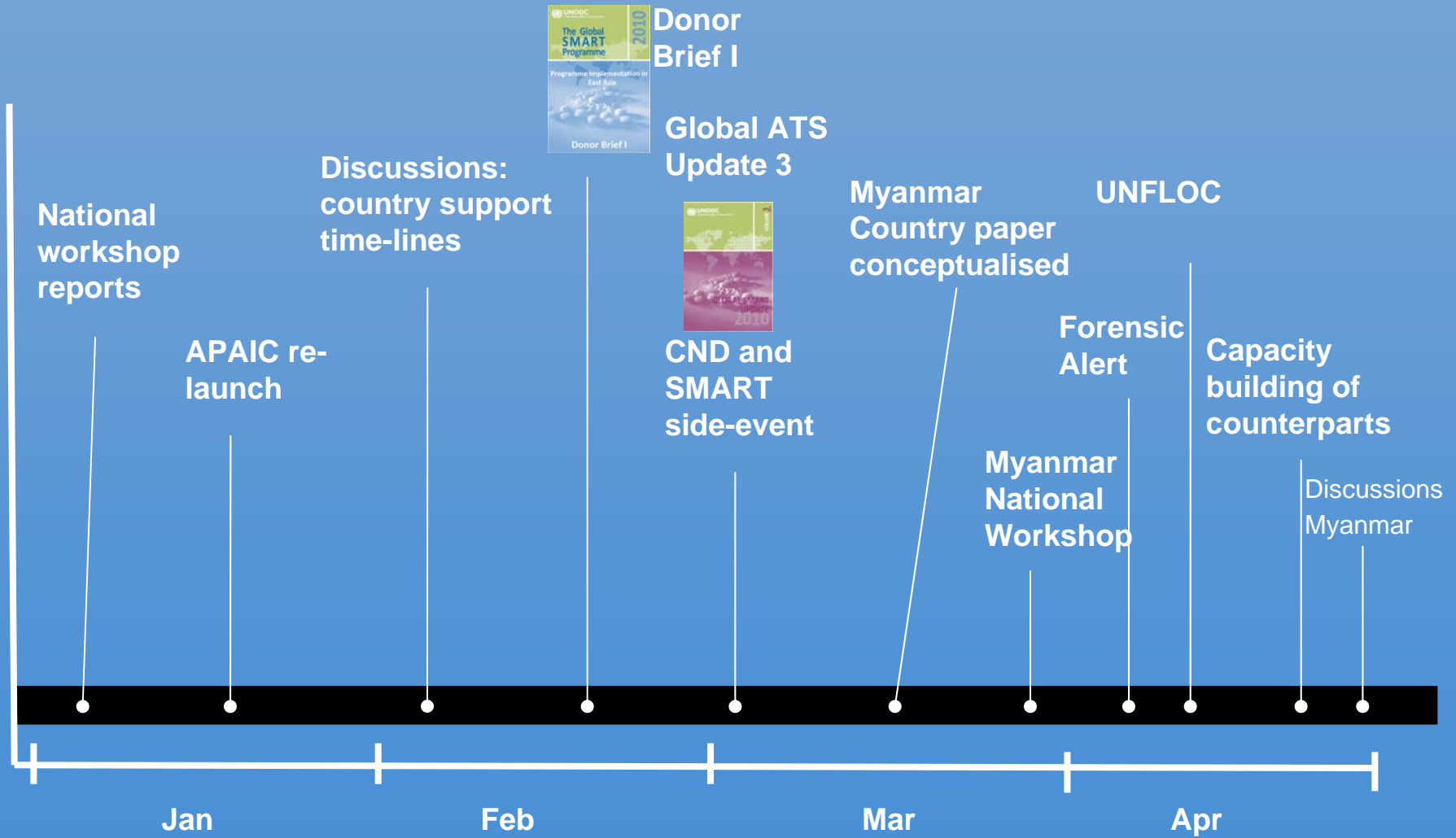

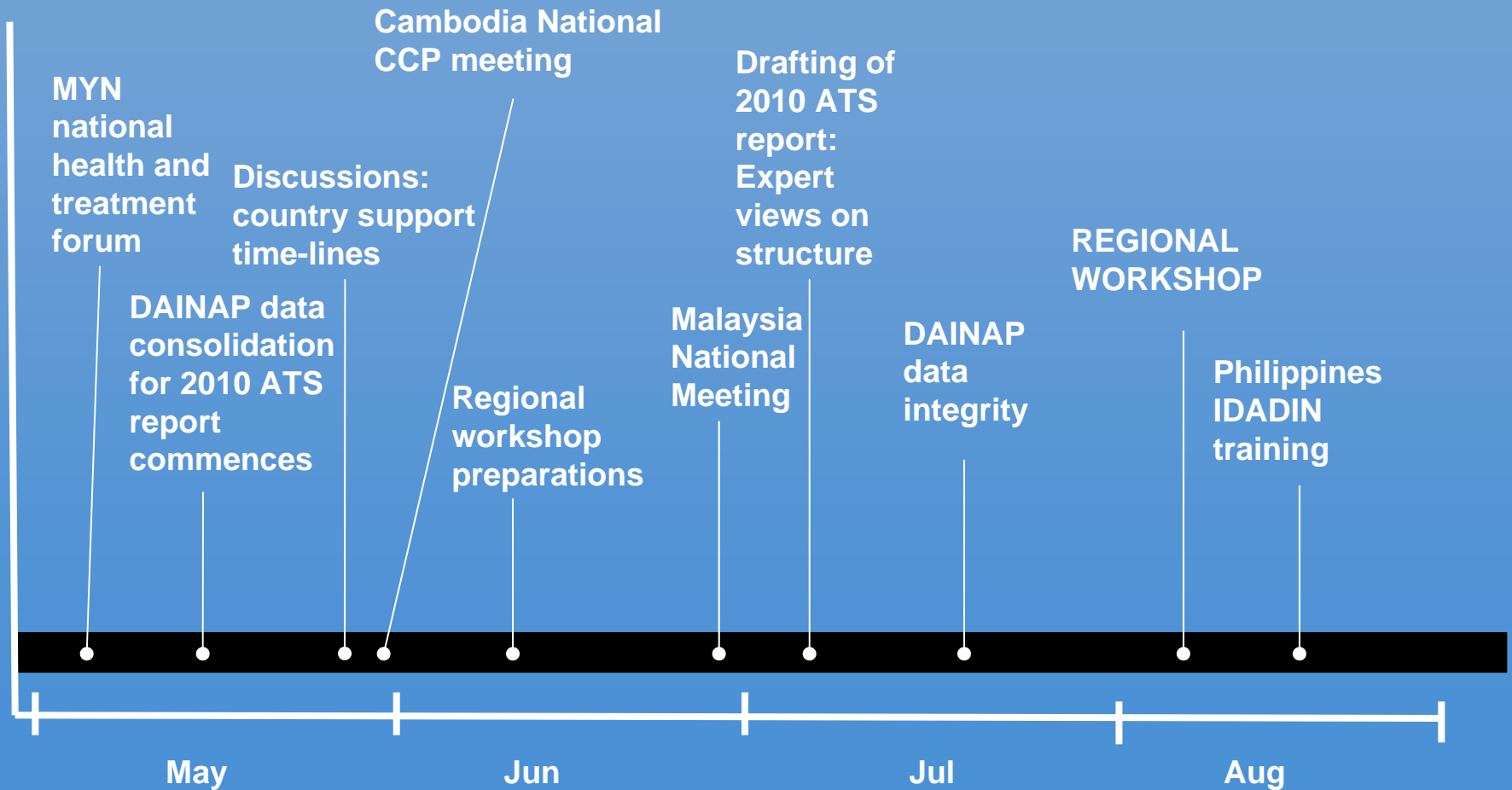


# Timeline 2010: Jan - Apr





# Timeline 2010: May - August



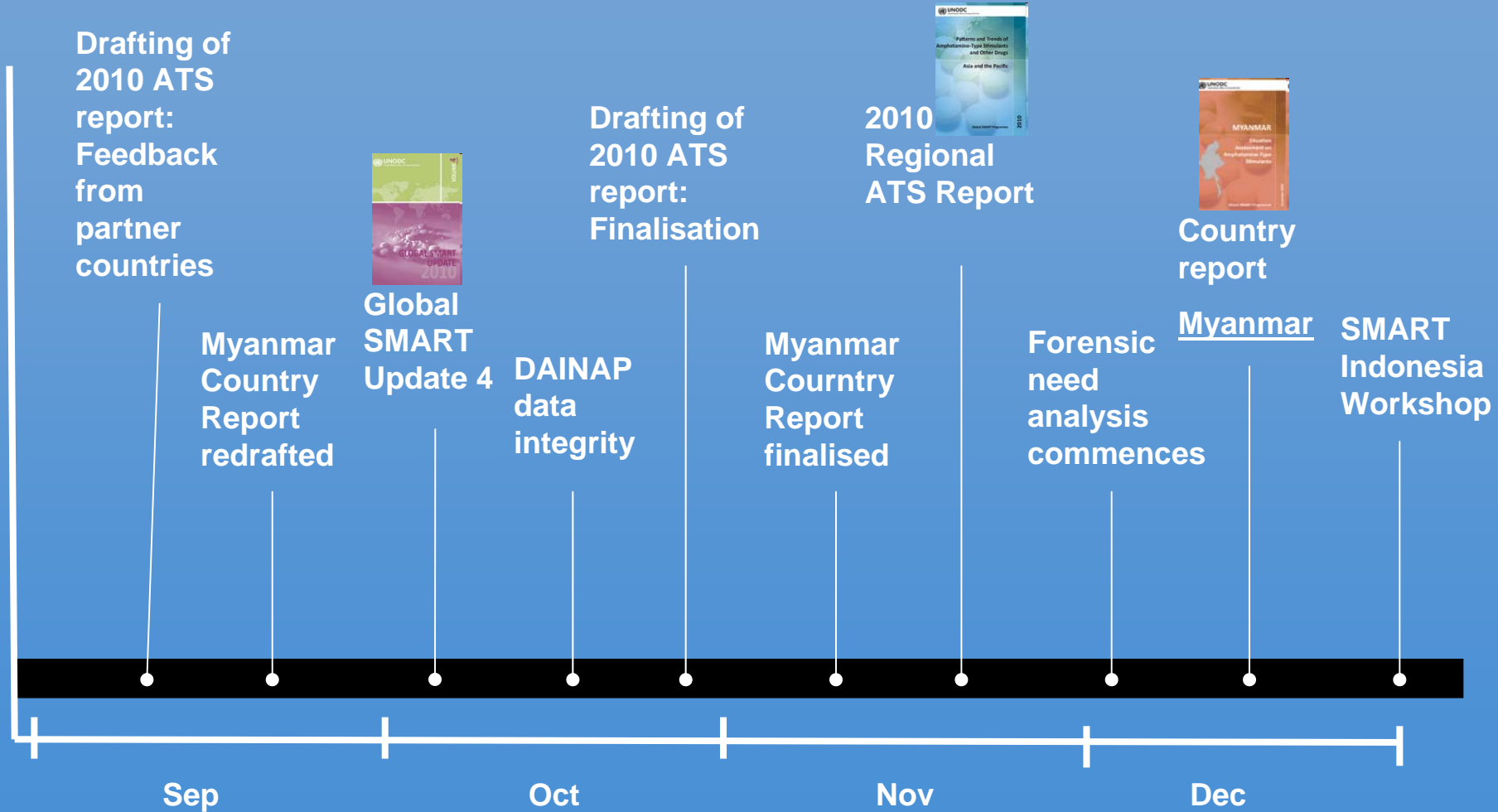

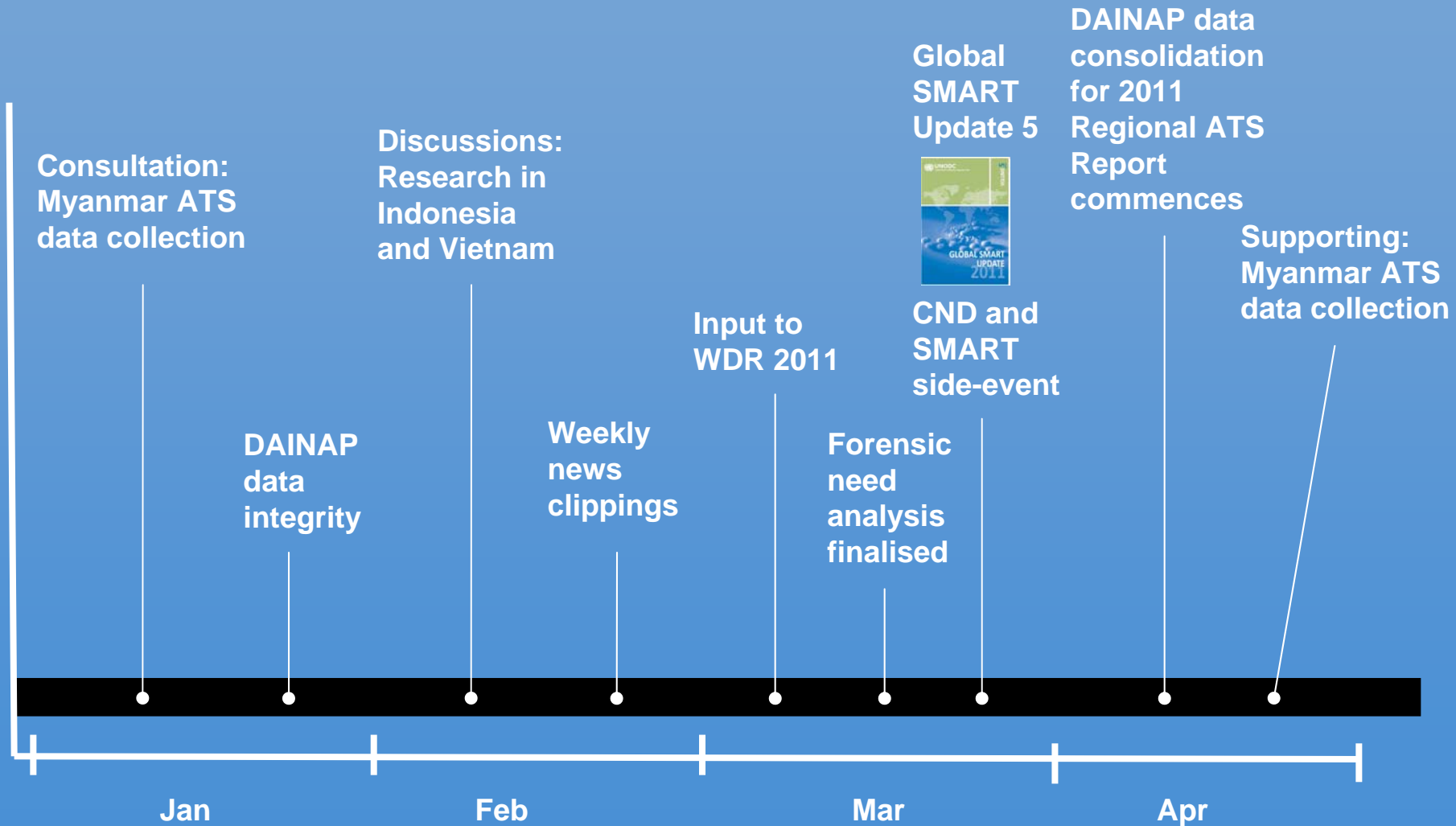
